1964

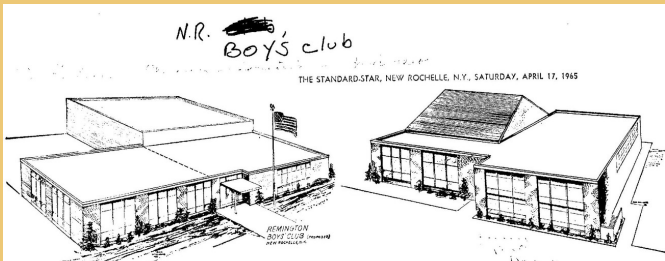


The Clubs Board of Directors unanimously voted to sponsor the City Park Branch after an appeal from parents and the Housing Authority to establish one for the boys in the area.

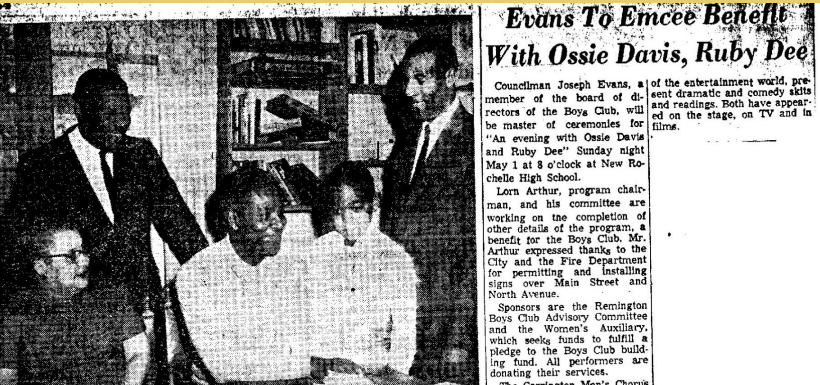
