Architectural Building by An Inspired Empty Vessel

Tuesday | Grades 3-5 | \$144

Children learn the fundamental principles of architecture; that of tension and compression, while simulating those principles in two models. The Teepee is literally stretched around its supporting poles which are staked into the "ground" to demonstrate tension. The Skyscraper gives the understanding of pylons in modern construction and affords games and laughter as we play with different designs of height, spiral, and "earthquake-proofness". Min 12/Max 12

Llama Drama By Sew Happy Sewing, Inc.

Tuesday | Grades 1-5 | \$240

"Llama Drama" is a hand sewing project which includes a llama stuffie with accessories (a blanket, legwarmers, hat and scarf!), a mug-rug and keychain. Students will learn how to thread a needle, tie a knot, make a lock stitch and the stitches used will be a straight stitch and a whip stitch. There will be cutting, pinning, matching pieces and stuffing, all of which improve fine motor skills and coordination. Min 8/Max 8

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Ceramics and Glass by Slavin Studios

Thursday | Grades K-5 | \$240

A fun and hands on introduction to art and design. On the days we do ceramics, students will shape clay into sculpture and functional items. They will use basic hand tools and even paint the clay with non-toxic clay based colored paints. These are taken back to the studio, fired, and glazed in a kiln to a shiny food safe finish! Project ideas are almost unlimited, so many wonderful things to make. Sculpture, cups, bowls, coil pots, slab working etc. The days we do Glass fusing, students take precut pieces of clear and colored glass to create art. They assemble and glue in place the glass design. Which gets taken back to the studio to be fused together in a kiln. Its colorful and works with shapes and design. Teacher can cut certain shapes as needed. Pendants, sun catchers, ornaments, jewelry, magnets, tiles even a small dish are some of the projects. Self-hardening clay can also be used as a sculpting medium that we can paint with acrylics. Fun, creative and immediate. Students will get back artwork throughout the program as their work undergoes its transformation to finished artwork. Get ready to be very happy with this afterschool program!!! Min 10/Max 25
