He is program coordinator of the My Brother's Keeper initiative for the City School District and City of New Rochelle (MBK New Ro), and actively works with students within all secondary schools in the school district. Nate's life's work has been to inspire others to believe that "the best is yet to come."


Prior to joining MBK New Ro, Nate was director of operations for Boys & Girls Club of New Rochelle (BGCNR) for seven years, overseeing daily operations of 13 school

sites and two clubhouses, and seeing membership increase nearly 200% during his tenure. While at BGCNR, he also established fruitful relationships with several Fortune 500 firms, including PepsiCo, Planet Fitness, Microsoft, and Viacom.

In 2016, Nate was certified by the North American Family Institute to collaborate with the City of New Rochelle to foster positive relationships between the city's youth and police officers. In addition, he is a member of New Rochelle African American Advisory Committee, and City School District of New Rochelle Safety, Code of Conduct, and Green School Committees. Nate helped to establish New Rochelle YTL Huguenot Elite Football, serving over 150 participants each year, and is president of the Metro North NY Youth Football and Cheer Program, serving youth from New Rochelle, Mt Vernon, Yonkers, White Plains, Peekskill, Poughkeepsie, and Spring Valley.

Along with his wife of 15 years, New Rochelle native Monique (McGuire) Adams, Nate is a proud parent of Lailah Monet Adams, a student of Albert Leonard Middle School, and Langston Carter Adams, who attends Barnard Elementary School.



# **ARNOLD (ARNIE) AUSTIN**

Arnold (Arnie) Austin was raised by a single mother in the projects of New Rochelle. An athletic child, he joined Boys & Girls Club of New Rochelle (BGCNR) to "stay out of trouble" while participating in a variety of sports activities. In his early years as a member, Arnie was drawn to football and track, and, with the support of BGCNR staff, continued to excel in both sports. He broke numerous sports records, and earned both local and state awards as a student athlete at New Rochelle High School (NRHS); some of his records still stand today, such as his 100-yard punt return. Arnie

was an all-county athlete in football and, while a member of the JV football team, scored five touchdowns in one game.

Arnie also holds the New York State record in the 180-yard low hurdles and was a member of the 880 record-breaking relay team. In addition, he was all-county in track and cocaptain of the track team. In recognition of his achievements, he received the Con Edison Award and was named "Best Athlete" at NRHS for the 1959-1960 academic year. Arnie eventually went on to play defensive back for the 1964 Westchester Crusaders of the Atlantic Coast Football League, and was inducted into the New Rochelle Sports Hall of Fame in 2004.

Most recently, Arnie has been a committed member of Remington Men's Club, which supports BGCNR's Remington Clubhouse facility and programming. He and his fellow members have provided funds for capital improvements, sponsored member trips, and funded college scholarships, and continue to contribute to BGCNR programs such as Keystone Club and summer camp.



# **NICOLE BELL-SIMON**

Nicole Bell-Simon is an accomplished finance executive and a very active community member. She holds an MBA from Harvard Business School and a BS in business administration, with concentrations in finance and accounting from the Wharton School, University of Pennsylvania.

Nicole has held numerous positions in finance and accounting, and currently serves as group vice president of financial planning and analysis at Gartner, Inc. She is passionate about driving diversity and inclusion efforts and is co-chair of

Gartner's Finance + Inclusion Council. Before joining Gartner, Nicole worked at American Express, John Wiley & Sons, LexisNexis, and Pepsi-Cola in various strategic and change management finance roles. Nicole is married to Steven Simon and is the proud mother of Tyler and Sydney. She is the daughter of Linda Bell and granddaughter of Frances Holcomb. Nicole owes them incredible gratitude as they shaped her into the woman she is today.



## **VIANNEY GODINEZ**

Selected among four outstanding local teens, Vianney Godinez was named 2023 Youth of the Year by Boys & Girls Club of New Rochelle (BGCNR) this past March. The Youth of the Year title is a prestigious honor bestowed upon an exemplary young person in recognition of leadership, service, academic excellence, and dedication to live a healthy lifestyle.

As Youth of the Year, Vianney will serve as an ambassador for all teens in New Rochelle, receive a \$1,000 college

scholarship from BGCNR, and advance to the New York State Youth of the Year competition, which will be held later this month.

A quintessential "club kid," Vianney is a leader who is bold, unafraid to always ask the tough questions, and a collaborative problem-solver. Her club journey began in kindergarten as a member of our Mascaro Clubhouse, and she has been a part of many BGCNR programs, including Smart Girls, Torch Club, and our new Youth Civics Council.

As a member of Youth Civics Council, Vianney had the opportunity to advocate for youth issues on Capitol Hill in Washington, DC, where she also toured the White House and met First Daughter Ashley Biden. In addition to her time at BGCNR, she serves as the junior class president at New Rochelle High School.



## **LUIS MERLO**

Luis Merlo has been involved with Boys & Girls Club of New Rochelle (BGCNR) for nearly 10 years as a parent, coach, and supporter. He has two sons who are active members of the club and is grateful for the opportunity to give back to an organization that has provided support, encouragement, and opportunity to his children and family. Today, he focuses his volunteer coaching efforts at BGCNR.

His eldest son became a member of the club as a first grader and, shortly after joining the basketball team, inspired Luis

to begin coaching. (He believes he was asked because of his enthusiastic cheering from the sidelines.) He has guided the team for four years now, helping youth who are new to the sport to develop basic skills and focus on self-improvement.

Luis began working at the young age of 15 and, after earning a GED at 21, entered the real estate field, specializing in short sale investments. He also is co-owner of a hair salon and convenience store in Westchester. In addition to his work coaching BGCNR's Mascaro basketball team, he has served as a volunteer coach at the Pelton Athletic Club in Yonkers, and has coached several local t-ball and flag football teams, including the Yonkers Knights. He is certified by USA Sports for baseball, flag football, and youth tackle football, and has attended New York Knicks coaching clinics to continue honing his skills as a mentor for youth athletes.



## **CANDACE PINN**

Candace Pinn is an independent consultant and retired educator, with 30 years of education experience and 26 years of service to the New Rochelle community. She began her career in Washington, DC, in the emerging computer communications field as a computer analyst. Candace held positions at National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA), National Weather Service, and Morgan Stanley, and, after the birth of her second child, returned to school to study education.

In addition to her background in technology, Candace is a natural teacher who completed an MA in education in 1994 while gaining experience teaching young children in New York City public and private schools. In 1996, she relocated her family to Westchester County and took a position at Barnard Elementary School in New Rochelle. Candace subsequently became a master early childhood educator while enjoying many leadership roles over her career; a culturally responsive education (CRE) staff developer/trainer; Federation of United School Employees (FUSE) representative; mentor teacher; and teacher leader and chairperson/representative of district-wide committees on diversity, equity and inclusion, curriculum and instruction, response to intervention (RTI), and nutrition.

After becoming a member of the Westchester Alliance of Black School Educators (WABSE) in 2006, she was elected president and has served in this capacity for over 11 years, guiding WABSE in its work to fund scholarships for college-bound students; increase its network; and provide meaningful educational and professional development experiences for adults and students. Candace also is an

activist leader supporting DEI initiatives by working with state legislators and the New York State Department of Education on education reform policy and law.

Since 1996, Candace and her family have been involved with Boys & Girls Club of New Rochelle, first as parents and participants and, eventually, as coaches and supporters. In 2007, Candace joined BGCNR's board, overseeing the organization's finances, staff management, marketing, fundraising, and community outreach. She later assumed the role of board secretary and, in 2013, was elected board chair and went on to advocate for representation on the leadership team to reflect the backgrounds and experiences of the children it serves.

Candace is a native of Brooklyn, NY and holds an MS in computer science from New York University, an MA in education from Columbia Teachers College, and a BS in general engineering from Tufts University. She has four adult children and resides with her husband in Mount Vernon, NY.

# THE REMINGTON MEN'S CLUB



Our organization was established by individuals who attended the Million Man March and returned to revitalize a volunteer organization once headed by members who were no longer active in the community. Since then, our mission has been to support Boys & Girls Club of New Rochelle's Remington Clubhouse, and help enhance its programs and facility in ways not provided for in the organization's budget.
