

Summer Brain Gain

Summer Brain Gain offers more than six weeks of developmentally appropriate project-based learning designed to prevent summer learning loss. The program materials include classic project-based learning as well as modules with a STEM or literacy focus.

Triple Play: Healthy Habits

Triple Play Healthy Habits focuses on helping youth make healthy eating choices. The program consists of 14 progressive, interactive, practical activities that develop a young person's skill, confidence and motivation to make healthy nutritional choices throughout life. Camp Wars: The Challenge

Camp Wars is a camp wide activity that consists of challenges for each group around the club. The groups accumulate points to determine at the end of the summer who the Camp Wars Champions are! Activities include talent shows, Boys & Girls Club Best Dance Crews & Olympic style games.





All Stars Sports

This progressive program focuses on building movement skills and positive attitudes about physical activity. The program consists of 32 diverse games, cooperative activities and sports to develop a young person's ability, confidence and motivation to be physically active. We also introduce new sports to all of campers including partnerships with JustinTimeBaseball!

Arts

Youth Arts High-Yield Activities are One-time exploratory experiences that can be implemented in any program area of the Club or Youth Center, any day of the year. Activities cover all four pillars of the arts – visual, performing, digital and applied.

A Day In The Life Of A BGCNR Camper

Rain or shine, BGCNR Summer Camp has plenty of fun in store for your child! Campers enjoy structured days packed with many engaging activities.



DAILY SCHEDULE

8:00 - 9:15 am	Drop Off and Pre- Camp Activities	Campers are checked in at front desk and brought to play stations throughout the building
9:15 - 9:30 am	Daily Kick Off	Directors, counselors, and campers meet to review activities planned for the day
9:30 am - 4:00 pm	Block Scheduling	Campers enjoy dedicated BGCA programming including: Summer Brain Gain, art classes, STEM activities, sports, team-building exercises, outdoor play, and performing arts sessions. Campers age 6 to 9 will have lunch from 11:45 am - 12:30 pm; campers aged 10 to 14 have lunch from 12:30 to 1:00 pm. Campers may bring their own meals or lunch will be provided to them.
4:00 - 4:45 pm	Snack Time	Snacks are provided to all campers from 4:00 to 4:30 pm.
4:45- 6:00 pm	Drop Off and Pre- Camp Activities	Campers await pickup while at designated play stations. Parents check in at front desk and sign out their children; children are paged and asked to come to the game room for dismissal.





Pricing

Mascaro & Remington Summer Camps

- Weekly Camp Rate- \$300 per week. (Week 1- \$250)
- All program refunds require advanced notice, credits are not issued for sickness or missed sessions, as we staff based on enrollment. Our capacity is limited, if your plans change, please advise us as quickly as possible.
- Payment installment plans are offered for your convenience, however, missing and past due payments, will result in cancellation of your child's registration.

<u>Scholarships</u>

• Scholarships are given out based on need. After you submit our scholarship committee will review and make a determination by June 15th. We usually do not give more than 2 weeks per child and require parents match the amount of scholarship we give out. So if you receive \$600 of scholarship money that covers 2 weeks, we require the parent to sign their child up for an additional 2 weeks. Current members are prioritized for scholarships. Deposits must be made and enrolled in a payment plan while we wait for scholarship determination.

DSS Childcare Subsidy

• We also accept the Westchester County Department of Social Services Childcare Subsidy. If you are applying for the DSS Childcare Subsidy please contact Mary Rivera at mrivera@bgcnr.org to sign the paperwork associated with that.
