# Mondays | Grades 1-5 | \$312

Hedgehog House is an adorable fabric basket decorated with a "little-house-in-the-woods" design. The introductory project is a bookmark, the main project is a basket with a pocket and a handle, and additional projects include a small stuffed hedgehog, a blanket, and a keychain.

### Junior Explorers by MAD Science

#### Mondays | Grades K-2 | \$358

Join Mad Science this session and discover why science is the real star on the big screen. You'll create cool sound effects and build your very own robot hand to take home in a class that focuses on technology. Harness the sun's heat and ramp up a power generation station. Get linked into a network and work with radio signals. Conduct hands-on experiments that will provide the opportunity to explore the force of gravity and even defy gravity! Some of the classes in this session include: Movie Effects, Sonic Sounds, The Science of Toys, Radical Robots, and Great Gravity.

# Circuit Adventures by MakeInspires

#### Mondays | Grades 3-5 | \$302

Circuit Adventures explores the world of electrons, also known as electricity. Circuits are used in devices all around us, from light switches to computers and even cars!
