The Boys & Girls Club of New Rochelle has been an anchor for Youth Development in the New Rochelle and Westchester Community for over 95 years. Currently we serve 12,000 kids annually at over 14 sites in New Rochelle, Larchmont and Mamaroneck!

Our mission is “To enable all young people, especially those who need us most, to reach their full potential as productive, caring, responsible citizens.”

Mascaro Summer Camp

- **Weekly Camp Rate - \$350 Program Weekly Fee**
- **10% deposit required at time of registration**
- **All program refunds require advanced notice; credits are not issued for sickness or missed sessions, as we staff based on enrollment. Our capacity is limited; if your plans change, please advise us as quickly as possible.**
- **Payment installment plans are required; however, missing and past due payments will result in cancellation of your child's registration.**

Scholarships

- **Scholarships are given out based on need. After you apply, our scholarship committee will review and make a determination by June 15th. We usually do not give more than 2 weeks per child and require parents match the amount of scholarship we give out. So if you receive \$700 of scholarship money that covers 2 weeks, we require the parent to sign their child up for an additional 2 weeks. Current members are prioritized for scholarships. Deposits must be made and enrolled in a payment plan while we wait for scholarship determination.**

DSS Childcare Subsidy

- **We also accept the Westchester County Department of Social Services Childcare Subsidy. If you are applying for the DSS Childcare Subsidy, please contact Fatima Muniz (fmuniz@bgcncr.org) to sign the paperwork associated with that. 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BGCNR Summer Programs



Summer Brain Gain offers more than six weeks of developmentally appropriate project-based learning designed to prevent summer learning loss. The program materials include classic project-based learning as well as modules with a STEM or literacy focus.



One-time exploratory experiences that can be implemented in any program area of the Club or Youth Center, any day of the year. Activities cover five pillars of the arts – visual, performing, digital, applied and literary. Art is meant to be shared, so we encourage Clubs to host local Arts contests and showcases and then to participate in BGCA’s annual National Arts Contest as a culminating experience.



This progressive program focuses on building movement skills and positive attitudes about physical activity. The program consists of 32 diverse games, cooperative activities and sports to develop a young person’s ability, confidence and motivation to be physically active.



DIY STEM includes a modular targeted program and a set of supplemental High Yield Activities. The targeted program is a set of 4 modules that provide both staff and youth an introduction to inquiry-based STEM activities, allowing youth to explore or build projects based on their own questions and observations. The activities are grouped into themed modules, but can be mixed and matched to respond to youth interests.

Block Scheduling

Campers age 6 to 9 will have lunch from 11:45 am - 12:30 pm; campers aged 10 to 14 have lunch from 12:30 to 1:00 pm. Campers may bring their own meals or lunch will be provided to them.
