Sew Ready is our adorable new kindergarten sewing program designed to gently introduce young children to sewing through playful puppy-themed projects and hands-on learning. Children begin by building confidence and coordination with puppy-themed threading boards, practicing important fine motor skills as they lace colourful cords through fun dog-shaped designs. They then progress to sewing on burlap hoops using plastic needles and yarn, learning basic stitching techniques in a safe and approachable way. Once they are ready, students complete their first sewn project using real metal needles to create an adorable felt puppy pouch. Designed especially for younger learners, the program also includes fun movement and sensory activities such as bead stringing, button hunts, and playful learning games to keep children engaged and excited throughout the session. Sew Ready encourages creativity, patience, fine motor development, independence, and confidence while introducing foundational sewing skills in a warm, age-appropriate environment.

- 1) Attendance, introduction, and warm-ups- We set the goals and expectations for the session and begin with a general warm-up
- 2) Strength and conditioning- We will learn and perfect basic exercises, including push-ups, squats, lunges, sit-ups, box jumps, jump rope, and more
- 3) Obstacle course- Using combinations of boxes, hurdles, agility ladders, gymnastic mats, and other available challenges, we will teach, practice, and run timed trials of an age-appropriate obstacle course
- 4) Games and cool down- Dodgeball, tug of war, freeze tag, sharks and minnows, and more.

Ceramics and Sculpture Arts

Here the studio art experience is brought to you! In Ceramics, we work with clay sculpting and students form their artwork by hand. Basic techniques are taught and demonstrations are given. The students paint their Ceramic art with non-toxic colors that are then transported to a kiln, bisque, and glaze fired with a clear food-safe finish. The beautiful and durable glazed ceramics are fun and students will learn the fundamentals of sculpture & hand-building techniques. Use of tools will be shown to create a vase or sculpture, planning to try a more extended project that is less rushed. Other mediums will be introduced, such as wood. Using pre-cut wood, popsicle sticks and some paint we will explore forming objects of art and function. Also wire sculpting to form people, animals, and contemporary art will be part of the sculpting. Teaching student's ways to bend colored pipe cleaner, and firmer wire into shapes and designs with a base. Artwork comes back to the classroom, as it's ready throughout the program. All artwork will be received by the last class. Usually, we finish with a self-hardening clay project they take home on the last day.
